Cost: \$550 - all inclusive including stabling fee. Campers bring their own horse feed. Stabling is temporary pipe corrals under a big tent on grass. Camp participants will enjoy 2 private lessons on Saturday and 2 private lessons on Sunday. Several lectures and demonstrations, all meals provided from Friday evening to end of day on Sunday. Friday late afternoon is for arriving and settling horses and warm up in the indoor arena, followed by a wine and cheese, meet and greet, and dinner.
