Entries: OPEN TO ALL RIDERS. It is not required to be an ODS member to enter.

To Enter: The League Show entry form can be found in two places: on the Fort Vancouver Chapter website at www.fortvancouverdressage.com and on the ODS website at www.oregondressage.com, in the Forms and Documents tab. On the Fort Vancouver Chapter website, the League Show entry form is a fillable document.

To pay electronically, there is a button on the Fort Vancouver Chapter website that allows you to use PayPal, Venmo, or your debit/credit card for payment. Alternatively, there is a QR code for your use. If you are paying electronically, please be sure to include both your name and your horse's name to your payment.

Check payment is also accepted, with checks payable to FVC/ODS, and mailed to the address below.

Classes at an ODS League show may be split by division: Youth, Adult Amateur, or Open.

Unspecified rider division on entry will be considered Open.

Rider Year End Awards: If you are an ODS member, you can submit your League Show scores to ODS to be recorded for year-end awards. Go to oregondressage.com "Horse and Rider Awards" for details.

FEES & REFUNDS:

Class Fees:

Individual Tests and Freestyles\$40/class

Youth (18 years of age or under as of January 1).....\$20/class

Pas de Deux and Quadrille.....\$25/rider

Post entries, if space available, in addition to class fee...\$10

Non-Refundable Fees:

Office fee (required per entry).....\$25

Returned check fee.....\$40

*PayPal transaction fees are non-refundable.

Stabling: Stalls are limited - enter early!

\$100/day or \$165/weekend – Please indicate your farm affiliation on your entry form.

Initial shavings only provided. Additional shavings \$15/bag.

Limited day turnout pens - enter early - \$40/day

Haul in Fees (for those without stabling): \$25/day per horse

Refunds: Until closing date: All monies refunded less the non-refundable fees.

After closing date: **Refunds only with letter from doctor or veterinarian.** Refunds of \$20.00 or less will be given out at the show. All other refunds will be mailed after the show.

ABOUT THE FACILITY

Friday schooling 2 pm – 7 pm.

Arenas & Footing: Outdoor Competition Arena is 20m x 60m with sand & fiber footing. Indoor warmup arena with sand and fiber footing. Please note that the round pen will not be available for use (including lunging) while classes are in session.

Dry Camping permitted. No dogs allowed.

Food: Food will be available for purchase on the showgrounds.

Parking: Please follow posted signage.

SCHEDULING & RIDE TIMES

Ride times will be available to riders five (5) days before the show at www.foxvillage.com.

Double check your ride times on Fox Village or at the office for any changes. Class scheduling may require changing the order of classes and ride times. Responsibility for obtaining ride time updates remains with the competitor.

Management reserves the right to drop or combine classes and substitute judges.

AWARDS

Awards to first place, ribbons to sixth place. High Point awards to Youth and Adult Amateur/Open each day.

ODS league show rules apply. Every rider is required to wear protective headgear while mounted and riding anywhere on the show grounds. This rule is defined by USEF DR120 and

other compliance with GR801. Horses need to wear their entry number anytime they are out of the stall or trailer.
