Classes at an ODS League show may be split by division, Junior, Adult Amateur or Open. Unspecified rider division on entry will be considered Open.

Stabling: Stalls are limited - enter early!

SCHEDULING & RIDE TIMES

Ride times will be available to riders 5 days before the show on Fox Village. Double check your ride times on Fox Village or at the office for any changes. Responsibility for obtaining ride times from show management remains with the competitor. Class scheduling may require changing the order of classes. Management reserves the right to drop or combine classes and substitute judges.

AWARDS

Awards to first place, ribbons to sixth place. Special awards to Open, Adult Amateur and Junior High Point both days. Special award and ribbon for all musical freestyles entries.

Local and ODS show rules apply. Every rider is required to wear protective headgear while mounted and riding anywhere on the show grounds. This rule is defined by USEF DR120 and other compliance with GR801. Horses need to wear their entry number any time they are out of the stall or trailer.
